

**BURLINGTON CITY CLERK'S NOTES OF INTEREST for SEPTEMBER 2015.**

**City Clerk's Office:**

- **Keep informed with IRIS - Free:** Get Immediate Response Information System ALERTS, at [www.coffeycountyks.org](http://www.coffeycountyks.org) or call Coffey County Emergency Management (620-364-2721).
- **Labor Day:** City Hall will be closed Monday, September 7th in observance of Labor Day.
- **Utility Level Pay Signup for 2015:** If you are not already on the City's Utility Level Pay Program and want to be added, please contact City Hall by October 20.
- **Free Tree Limb & Brush Dump:** Residents of Burlington may dump only brush and tree limbs at the City Burn Pile south of the City Dam. Just stop by City Hall and sign out the key. Key is loaned only during City work hours.

**Electric Department Distribution** personnel will be trimming trees, doing line locates and work orders; installing electric services, and performing line maintenance.

**Electric Department Production** personnel will do general Power Plant and generator maintenance, and doing required reports.

**Parks Department** will install self-pay stations at RV Parks, clean public buildings and restrooms, mow, weed-eat, and spray weeds.

**Police Department will:**

- Be active in school zones and the construction zone.
- Help with the **OK Kids event**, Sept 12 and 13.
- Help with the **Drive In Flu Clinic** at Coffey County Hospital on Friday morning, October 2 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.
- Help with **Drug Take-Back Program**: October 2 during Flu Clinic at CCH Hospital. Any drugs, over the counter or prescription including those from the veterinarian for your pets will be accepted, no questions asked.
- Host an Police Department Open House, 616 S. on Saturday, Oct 3, during the Taste of Fall festival at Kelley Park. Hours for the open house will be announced.
- Continue to work nuisance properties. Please take advantage of Burlington's City-wide Fall Cleanup in October.

**Street Department** personnel will be working rebuilding streets in town, and working with the county on the 2015 chip seals.

**Water Department:** normal duties, waterline replacement on Niagara, tilling and seeding work areas, and cleaning out basins at the Water Treatment Plant.
