

4-613. APPEALS FROM ORDER. Any person affected by an order issued by the governing body under this article may, within 30 days following service of the order, petition the district court of the county in which the structure is located for an injunction restraining the enforcing officer from carrying out the provisions of the order pending final disposition of the case. (Ord. 568, Sec. 13; Code 1997)

4-614. SCOPE OF ARTICLE. Nothing in this article shall be construed to abrogate or impair the powers of the courts or of any department of the city to enforce any provisions of its charter or its ordinances or regulations, nor to prevent or punish violations thereof; and the powers conferred by this article shall be in addition to and supplemental to the powers conferred by the constitution, any other law or ordinance. Nothing in this article shall be construed to impair or limit in any way the power of the city to define and declare nuisances and to cause their removal or abatement by summary proceedings or otherwise or to exercise those powers granted specifically by K.S.A. 12-1750:1756. ### **ARTICLE 7. HOUSE NUMBERING**

4-701. REQUIRED. All buildings fronting on any public street in this city shall be numbered as provided in this article. (Code 1985, 21-81)

4-702. SCHEME. The system of numbering herein adopted shall be known as the Philadelphia system. One hundred numbers shall be allowed to each block, each number representing 25 feet frontage on the streets running north and south and 25 feet frontage on the streets running east and west. The numbers on streets running north and south shall be numbered commencing at number 101 on the east side and numbered 100 on the west side, from Neosho Street each way; and the streets running east and west shall be numbered commencing at city limits on east and numbered 100 on the north side and numbered 101 on the south side; the odd numbers to be on the east and south and the even numbers on the west and north sides of the streets respectively. On those streets that do not connect with north or south streets or east and west streets numbering shall begin at the end of such streets nearest to north and south streets or east and west streets as the case may be, and shall correspond in number with the streets parallel therewith. (Code 1985, 21-82)

4-703. NUMBERS TO BE PLACED ON BUILDINGS. All buildings fronting on any street or alley shall have conspicuously placed on such buildings the number provided by this article. (Code 1985, 21-83)

4-704. SPECIFICATIONS FOR NUMBERS. The number plate placed upon any building shall be of metal or other suitable durable material and may be placed upon the front of the building, door, post, transom or other place. The numbers shall be at least three inches so as to be easily seen from the street. (Code 1985, 21-84)
