

RESOLUTION 2015-11

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE END OF A WATER/DROUGHT EMERGENCY FOR CITY OF BURLINGTON, KANSAS AND ITS WATER CONSUMERS, INCLUDING RURAL WATER DISTRICT 2 AND RURAL WATER DISTRICT 3 AND THE CITIES OF GRIDLEY, LEROY, AND NEW STRAWN, KANSAS; AS REQUIRED BY CITY OF BURLINGTON EMERGENCY WATER OPERATIONS/SUPPLY PLAN, DROUGHT/EMERGENCY CONTINGENCY PLAN AND CITY ORDINANCE NO. 536.

WHEREAS, the Burlington Water Treatment Plant receives water from the Cottonwood and Neosho River Basins Water Assurance District No. 3; and

WHEREAS, on June 30, 2015, the Governor Sam Brownback and the Kansas Water Office rescinded the Drought Water Emergency for Cottonwood & Neosho River Basins Water Assurance District #3; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Ordinance 536, Section 3, a resolution is required to declare a drought water emergency and another is required to rescind said water emergency; said resolutions shall be effective upon passage and publication in the official city newspaper;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGTON, KANSAS THAT:

SECTION 1. The Governing Body of the City of Burlington hereby declares that City of Burlington and all water customers thereof are no longer under a Drought Water Emergency, and that the Stage 1 Drought Water Watch declared by Resolution 2013-04 is no longer in effect. and

SECTION 2. Resolution 2015-10 and all resolutions in conflict shall be hereby rescinded.

SECTION 3. This Resolution 2015-11 is in full force from time of passage and publication in the City's official newspaper, and the Water Emergency shall be officially ended.
