BRUSH AND LIMBS MUST BE CUT IN MANAGEABLE LENGTH OF 10 FEET MAX.

FREE TRASH HAULING

Trash must be at the curb

PRIOR TO 7AM, MONDAY, APRIL 13, 2020

NO PICK UP OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS

TIRES -- GARBAGE -- HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE -- BRUSH OR LIMBS

No Demolition Items: NO HOUSE, TRAILER HOUSE, GARAGE, CONCRETE FOUNDATIONS, DRIVEWAYS, CONCRETE PADS OR ANY STRUCTURES WILL BE PICKED UP** NO EXCEPTIONS!!!****

Tires: Residents may take to the Landfill (A disposal fee is charged)

Trash: Residents may take trash to the Landfill through Saturday FREE of charge.

Chemicals & Paints: Residents must take them to Coffey County Weed Department.

Asbestos: Call the Landfill to make arrangements for disposal.

TRASH MUST AT THE CURB PRIOR TO 7 A.M., MONDAY, APRIL 13.

ITEMS MUST BE SEPARATED AND PLACED PARALLEL TO THE CURB IN 3 PILES:

- 1) CLEAN WOOD, BOARDS, PARTICLE BOARD, TREATED LUMBER
FURNITURE & MATTRESSES
- 2) BAGGED TRASH & LEAVES (NO GARBAGE)
PLASTIC MATERIALS
- 3) APPLIANCES AND METALS

ALL ITEMS MUST BE EASILY ACCESSIBLE from the street with a front-end loader.

DO NOT PLACE ITEMS UNDER GUY WIRES.
