

ORDINANCE NO. 899

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 862 & CHAPTER III - 209, BEVERAGES OF THE CODE OF CITY OF BURLINGTON, KANSAS, AND REPEALING ANY ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT, TO BE EFFECTIVE ON AND AFTER SEPTEMBER 6, 2023.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGTON, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: Chapter III - 209 of the Code of City of Burlington, Kansas will be amended to read as follows.

3-209. CITY-OWNED PROPERTY – CMB AND ALCOHOL REGULATIONS

(a) No person shall possess or consume any alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage within the confines and boundaries of any city-owned property, including municipal parks, within the city limits of Burlington, with the following exceptions as permitted:

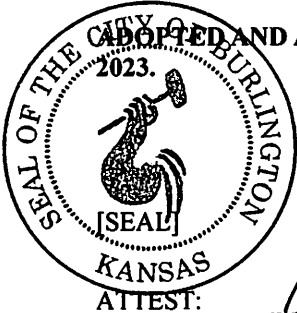
- (1) Drake Park
- (2) Within the confines of the Community Buildings (Kelley Hall and 4-H Building) in Kelley Park when a 'Permit to Allow Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages in Kelley Hall or 4-H Building' for which there is a \$15 fee and a \$100 refundable deposit required upon renting the building.
- (3) When authorized by the City Council within the confines and boundaries of any city owned property and municipal parks.



SECTION 2: This Ordinance 899 shall amend Chapter III -209 of the Code of City of Burlington, Kansas and amends any ordinances in conflict.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall become effective and be in full force and effect after its summary is published in the local official newspaper, and the entire Ordinance is published on the City's Website (burlingtonkans.gov.)
