**ORDINANCE 877**

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF GRASS CLIPPINGS AND  
OTHER YARD WASTE ON PUBLIC SURFACES**

- a. It is hereby unlawful for any person, persons, or firm to, by any means, deposit, or cause to be deposited, any grass clippings or other yard waste in any public roads or sidewalks, including alleyways.
- b. Responsibility for violations of this ordinance shall fall on both the property owner or lessee, depending on who, in the lease agreement, is named as responsible for the maintenance of the exterior of the leased structure, and, in cases where applicable, individuals hired for lawn maintenance.
- c. Persons in violation of this ordinance shall upon conviction be finable of up to one hundred dollars, jailable for up to thirty days, or punishable by both a fine and imprisonment.
- d. This Ordinance shall take effect after its passage and having been published once in the official city newspaper.
