

**ORDINANCE NO. 921**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING § 14-201 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF BURLINGTON, KANSAS, RELATING TO THE IDENTIFICATION OF TRAFFIC-CONTROL DEVICES AND MARKINGS.

WHEREAS, the Code of the City of Burlington, Kansas, has previously required that official traffic-control devices be identified on a map filed with the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body finds that maintaining and updating a single consolidated map is administratively burdensome and less precise than a written appendix identifying each traffic-control device and its location; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to amend § 14-201 of the City Code to allow traffic-control devices to be established by resolution with an appendix identifying the devices and their locations, while maintaining public accessibility and legal enforceability;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGTON, KANSAS:

**Section 1.**

§ 14-201, "Traffic-Control Devices and Markings," is hereby amended to read as follows:

(a) The Standard Traffic Ordinance, as adopted, is hereby modified by adding thereto the following.

(b) The governing body may, by resolution, establish and fix the location of such traffic-control devices as may be deemed necessary to guide and warn traffic under the provisions of this chapter, other traffic ordinances, and the laws of the State of Kansas. The City shall place and maintain such traffic-control signs, signals, and devices when and as may be required by the authority of the governing body to make effective the provisions of this chapter and other ordinances for the regulation of traffic.

Any resolution adopted pursuant to this section shall incorporate, by attachment or appendix, a schedule identifying each official traffic-control device established by the resolution and its specific location. The appendix or schedule shall be filed with the City Clerk, shall be open to inspection, and shall be available to the public during regular business hours. The absence of a citywide map shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any traffic-control device lawfully established under this section.

**Section 2.**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 3.**


This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication of a summary of the ordinance in the official city newspaper and on the City's website.
