

**ORDINANCE NO. 885**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER V: BUSINESS REGULATIONS, ARTICLE 5: MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS AND SALES, SECTION 5-505 TRANSIENT MERCHANTS OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BURLINGTON.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGTON, KANSAS.


SECTION 1. Section 5-505 of Article 5, Chapter 5, of the Code of the City of Burlington, Kansas, is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

Section 5-505. Transient Merchants.


- (a) The term “transient merchant” shall include a person who advertises for sale a stock of goods brought into the city and to be kept there for a short time or limited period, or who advertises the stock of goods for sale for the purpose of closing out any salvaged stock of goods, for sale for the purpose of closing out any salvaged wreckage, fire or bankrupt sale, or a person who makes the practice of moving a stock of goods from municipality to municipality for the purpose of selling for a short time or limited period from that stock or stocks of goods at each municipality.
- (b) Each transient merchant engaged in such business in the city shall have a current transient merchant license when conducting such business in the city.
- (c) A transient merchant license may be purchased
  - a. for \$50.00 and be valid for 6 months from the date purchased, or
  - b. for \$100.00 and be valid for 12 months from the date purchased.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance amends Section 5-505 of Article 5, Chapter 5, of the Code of the City of Burlington, Kansas, which was codified by Ordinance 851, and supersedes any other Ordinance in conflict.
